Institutions involved	General Sub-Directorate for Teacher Training and the General Directorate for VET
Description	At the request of the General Sub-Directorate for Teacher Training and the General Directorate for Vocational Training collaborated in the design and delivery of training sessions for Secondary School teachers and employment office counselors to explain the whole VET system, including the Dual VET modality.
Main Results	Through the workshops, a total of 118 education counselors and 105 employment counselors were reached. The two subsystems (education and labor) worked together to get to know the most important aspects of VET, in order to have a more complete understanding, to find talented students and be able to better guide them into VET
