Description	One of the principles underlying education in the Netherlands, guaranteed under article 23 of the constitution, is freedom of education. This means there is freedom to establish schools, freedom to organize teaching, and to determine the principles on which education is based (freedom of conviction). Freedom to organize teaching means that both public and private schools are free to determine – within legal boundaries – what is taught and how.
