Description	<p>Olympiad in subjects from the curricular technology area.</p> <p>Every year, the students of the Technical College Remus Radulet are participants and laureates at county and national school competitions and Olympiads, especially in the fields which are part of their main qualifications.</p> <p>The most talented students in the school participate in these Olympiads. Of significant importance is the participation of these students in mobility projects. For both participation, there is a selection at the school level. The most talented students are chosen through this selection, which includes both practical and theoretical tests. Students wishing to participate in these competitions/Olympiads are trained by dedicated mentor teachers. After participating in the Olympiad, if they also get awarded places, the students will receive diplomas that will give them a considerable advantage when they are admitted to college. Since 1998, 27 students have obtained recognition for the quality of professional training in CTRR through, prizes at county competitions and 11 at national competitions.</p>
